

We anticipate again making embroidered labels with words of encouragement which can be applied to the blankets using 6x6'' pieces of a washable stitching fabric for a 4x4'' stitching area on your label.

# APRIL 2024 – SHADING WITH CREWEL STITCHES THaP BY JUDY JEROY

This lovely program will be Shading with Crewel Stitches – a Take Home a Program by Judy Jeroy which will be taught by Lisa McGinnis. This project was the Take Home a Project (ThaP) at the MAR Spring 2023 Region Meeting. At this program, you will use basic stitches to shade a floral design, including chain stitch, burden stitch, French knots, coral knots, and stem/outline stitch. This is a way to stitch shading without using long and short stitches. The stitches in this program are fun to do and meditative once you get them started.

For this program, you should bring a 7" screw-adjustable embroidery hoop, crewel needles sizes 22, 24 and 26, and scissors. You can bring a battery-operated light and magnifier, if you prefer. The fabric for this program will be provided. An outline of the design will be on the fabric.

A PDF of the program directions with color pictures will be provided before the meeting by email. If you would like a black and white printout of the directions, let me know.

This program uses wool threads. Three colors in three shades of light, medium and dark are used in this program. In January, wool thread was provided for the Bargello frame weight program. You are welcome to use the wool you gathered at that meeting. If you would like wool for this program, let me know and it will be provided at the meeting. This is a free program.



# MAY 2024 – BARGELLO STUDY BOX

The May program will showcase the Florentine and Related Embroidery Study Box from the National EGA office. The Florentine Study Box is a detailed study of what is popularly known as Bargello and includes over 100 worked examples of traditional patterns, contemporary adaptations, and color study. The Study Box will continue the conversation on Bargello that we began in January 2024, when we began the Bargello frame weight program.



# JUNE 2024 – BABY, YOU'RE A FIREWORK!

The June program is a fun EGA Stitch-A-Long program from July 2023. The instructions were written by Dianne Stauber. The program will be taught by Lisa McGinnis. This project celebrates not only our nation's independence, but also the uniqueness of every one of us. Fireworks are beautiful and they all sparkle differently . . . just like us. So, grab a piece of fabric from your stash, some pretty fibers, and stitch something as unique as you!

To prepare for the Stitch-A-Long, you will need some sparkly fibers like Kreinik or Treasure Braid or Fyre Works, and any other complementary threads in cotton or silk. The ground fabric can be a towel, or t-shirt, or any other fabric you would like to use to display your Firework(s).
