#### MEMBERSHIP UPDATES -

The PAC currently has 30 members and 6 plural members. We are pleased at the prospect of several new members joining soon.

This year, National EGA is implementing an online dues payment process for members which will begin on April 1, 2024 (do not try to renew your membership before that date). Members will use a a credit card, Apple Pay, and Google Pay to pay their membership dues. ## JANUARY MEETING - BARGELLO FRAME WEIGHT

Let's try Bargello! This very old technique is very rhythmic and fun to do. We will try a small piece of Bargello in a flame pattern. You can make this into a frame weight/paperweight, or just do the center square and use it however you wish.

The chapter has a stash of many different wool threads that were donated, so we are going to use those, and the Chapter has paid for the 18-count canvas! *This is an in-person-only event!* Come on out and enjoy! We will not be mailing kits. Your kit will contain the 7" square of canvas with the outline drawn on it, one hank each of black and white yarns, and the chart with starting instructions. You can choose your own color combo of 5 other colors from the wools we have in the Chapter stash!

Supplies you will need to bring: Tapestry needle in a size 20 or 22, and your usual stitching supplies; scissors, lighting, magnification if needed. This will be done "in hand", so no frame is required. If you find that you absolutely need a frame after trying this, you will need a 7" square frame and tacks.

So far, we have 14 members registered for what will be a fun project!





# APRIL 2024 – SHADING WITH CREWEL STITCHES THAP BY JUDY JEROY

This project was the Take Home a Project (ThaP) at the MAR Spring 2023 Region Meeting. Lisa McGinnis will lead the PAC through the basic stitches to shade a floral design, including chain, burden stitch, French knots, coral knots, and stem/outline stitch. There are no long and short stitches in the project! You should plan to bring a 7" screw-adjustable embroidery hoop, scissors, and lights and magnifier, if needed. Further details about supplies will be provided in the future.
