IMPORTANT! ~ BOARD VOTES TO END DUES SUBSIDY

Several years ago, the PAC Board voted to subsidize primary members' dues by \$7 to offset increases in dues by EGA National. We have recently received messages of concern about this from Mid-Atlantic Region and National officials. They expressed to us that this was unfair, as it only applied to primary members. Our response was that only primary members paid National dues through our chapter. The officials remained concerned that this practice could appear discriminatory and requested that we change it.

In response to this concern, the PAC Board voted at their December 2022 meeting to discontinue the subsidy as of the 2023 dues renewal. Therefore, ALL chapter members will pay Chapter dues of \$16 in May 2023. National dues and Mid-Atlantic Region dues remain the same at \$39 and \$2, respectively.

Total dues for 2023 will be:

Primary members \$57

Plural members within MAR \$16

Plural members outside MAR \$18 (includes \$2 to MAR)

MEMBERSHIP UPDATES -

The PAC currently has 24 members and 6 plural members.

Our dues breakdown as of May 2023 is as follows:

Chapter dues \$16

MidAtlantic Region dues \$2 (MAR no longer prorates dues for partial-year membership) EGA National dues \$39

As of May 2023, primary members pay \$57, while plural members within MAR pay \$16 (chapter dues only), and plural members outside MAR pay \$18, as PAC pays their \$2 to MAR.

MARCH & APRIL MEETINGS - BEE-JEWELED PINCUSHION BY MARY CORBET

This lovely little pincushion uses simple surface embroidery stitches and some bead embellishment, as well as a fun tutorial on finishing. We thought it would be a perfect SPRING project!


This is a free project from Mary's website, which she published over several weeks. The texts are long; it totals over 34 pages! So Patty will be emailing the whole thing as one PDF for you to keep on your computer. You can read thru the whole project and decide which pages you need to print. Most of them you can just read and keep in your computer! Mary did make kits last year for this project, but they are currently sold out. She MAY have them back in stock before our meeting. Her kits were around \$23, and we will let you know if they become available again.

In case Mary does not get the kits back in stock, PLAN B is that Patty Smith Gardner will make up kits for the chapter. Patty can put kits together of the beads, some oatmeal colored linen, a piece of board for the base, and some of the Pellon interfacing. Patty used ground walnut shells for the filling, as it adds a nice heft to the pincushion, and can add those to the kits. As there are only four colors of DMC floss needed, you can pull those from your stash. The four colors are: two shades of green, a white, and another color you like for the knotted borders. A full list of what will be included in the chapter kit and the kit cost will be announced later. Patty will put out an email for kit reservations and estimates the cost will be approximately \$10-15.

At the chapter meeting on March 22, 2023, Gerty Romer will get us started tracing the pattern and stitching the project, and at the chapter meeting on April 26, 2023, Patty will cover finishing the pincushion.






Hello Prospective Member!
