# JULY & AUGUST MEETINGS - FAVORITE MEDALLION #1 PETITE PROJECT

Margaret Hardie will teach Favorite Medallion #1, which combines pulled thread and satin and is suitable for all skill levels. The pattern can be found on the EGA National website. Please bring your own copy to the meeting, but Margaret will print extra copies and will bring some stash fabric and thread for practice pieces if you don't have it in your stash. PLEASE TRY TO DO THE BASTING AHEAD OF TIME, at least to the center line of your practice piece.

#### Materials needed:

- 28ct linen or even weave fabric (6x6" for practice piece – 9x9" for piece to finish)
- Perle cotton thread size 12 & 5 to coordinate with fabric color
- Tapestry needles size 26 & 28
- 6" & 8" hoops
- Scissors to cut thread & light and/or magnification, if needed.
- Pattern from EGA National website



#### SEPTEMBER MEETING - OUTREACH IN FLEECE

The PAC will again be providing fleece blankets for those in need this year. Please purchase approximately 2 yards of polar fleece material (solids and patterns suitable primarily for older teenagers and adults only, please) for each blanket as a donation to this worthwhile cause. We will also be collecting new adult-size white tube socks for shelter residents.

This year, Margaret Hardie and Liz Gilbert have developed ideas for separate, embroidered labels which can be applied to the blankets. Use 6x6" pieces of washable stitching fabric for a 4x4" stitching area on your label (2" seam allowance on all sides). The labels can be stitched onto the blanket in whatever manner you prefer. The labels should be gender and age-neutral, be non-religious in nature, and have positive quotes and words of encouragement. Liz recently sent an email message to the chapter members with a number of suggested quotes, but feel free to use others that conform to the guidelines. Please be sure to use cotton embroidery floss and make sure that your patch is washable!

### OCTOBER MEETING - MAGNOLIA LEAF THAP

Gerty Romer-Harts will be teaching the Blackwork on Nature's Palette THAP by Catherine Jordan from the Fall 2022 MAR Meeting. This class uses the Blackwork technique on a leaf from a magnolia tree. You will learn how to transfer a grid to a solid surface and also how to make beautiful patterning using reversible double running stitches to keep the back as neat of the project as neat as possible. Watch for details regarding this project!






#### Hello Prospective Member!
